JUDGMENT

- 1. The tribunal has no jurisdiction to consider whether the respondent breached the duty to make adjustments by:
 - 1.1. failing on 20 March 2017 to ensure that claimant was not directly line managed by Ms Lynas;
 - 1.2. failing on 19 March 2017 to permit the claimant to work from home; and
 - 1.3. failing prior to 12 August 2017 to redeploy the claimant into a different role.
- 2. In any event, the respondent did not breach the duty to make adjustments in those respects or in any of the other alleged respects.
- 3. The respondent did not discriminate against the claimant arising from disability.
- 4. The claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- 5. Had the respondent acted fairly, the claimant would inevitably have been dismissed by notice given in the middle of January 2016.

CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER

By consent:

- 1. Rotherham, Doncaster and South Humber NHS Foundation Trust is added as a respondent in substitution for The NHS Leadership Academy
- 2. The claimant's remedy will be determined at a separate hearing to take place on **18 September 2017 at 10.00am** with a time allocation of **one day.**
