JUDGMENT

It is the unanimous judgment of the Employment Tribunal that:

1. The claim of unfair dismissal succeeds. The respondent is Ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £2063.40 calculated as follows:-

Basic Award 3 x £115.20 (weekly pay) Loss of statutory rights		£ 345.60 £ 230.40
Compensatory Award 37 x £115.20 Less		£4262.40
37 x ESA (£75.00)	Total	<u>£2775.00</u> £1487.40

Grand Total <u>£2063.40</u>

- 2. The claim of failure to pay accrued holiday succeeds and the respondent is Ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £57.60.
- 3. The claims of indirect discrimination, direct discrimination and harassment because of or related to race are dismissed.
- 4. The claim of failure to allow lunch breaks fails and is dismissed.
