#### **JUDGMENT**

### The Judgment of the tribunal is that: -

- 1 The claimant's claim for unfair dismissal is dismissed for want of jurisdiction.
- The claimant's application to amend her claims in accordance with the further Information presented to the tribunal by email dated 18 August 2017 is refused.
- Pursuant to Rule 37(1) of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure, the claimant's claims for discrimination on the grounds of Race; Sex; Age; and Religion together with her claims for Arrears of Pay and Holiday Pay are struck-out as having no reasonable prospect of success.
- The claimant's claim for Unpaid Notice Pay/Breach of Contract will be heard by an Employment Judge sitting without members at London Central Employment Tribunal on Thursday **26 October 2017** with a time allocation of 1 day.
