## **JUDGMENT**

The complaint of unauthorised deductions from wages is dismissed pursuant to rule 47 of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013.

## REASONS

- 1. The respondent had resisted the complaint of unauthorised deduction from wages in the response implying that the claimant had resigned.
- 2. Neither party attended the hearing. The tribunal attempted to contact both parties by telephone without response.
- 3. In such a case as this the claimant has to prove that the respondent made unauthorised deductions from wages and the amount so deducted. In the absence of evidence the tribunal could not resolve the dispute between the parties. On that basis the tribunal could not find that the claimant had proved his claim.
- 4. For that reason I dismiss the claim.
