JUDGMENT

1. Despite the absence of Mr Gerard Conteh, sole director of the respondent company, the matter will proceed in his absence.
2. The judgment of the Tribunal is that the claimant's claims for notice pay and holiday pay both succeed, and in terms of notice pay the claimant is due from the respondent the sum of £2,610 and in relation to holiday pay the sum of £4,463.10.
3. The respondent should also repay to the claimant the sum of £365 Tribunal fees.
4. That makes a total of £7,438.10 that I order the respondent to pay to the claimant forthwith.

THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNALS (INTEREST) ORDER 1990

The Employment Tribunals (Interest) Order 1990 provides that sums of money payable as a result of a judgment of an Employment Tribunal (excluding sums representing costs or expenses), shall carry interest where the full amount is not paid within 14 days after the day that the document containing the tribunal's written judgment is recorded as having been sent to parties. That day is known as "*the relevant decision day*". The date from which interest starts to accrue is called "*the calculation day*" and is the day immediately following the relevant decision day.

The rate of interest payable is that specified in section 17 of the Judgments Act 1838 on the relevant decision day. This is known as "the stipulated rate of interest" and the rate applicable in your case is set out below.
