JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

1. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and is ordered to pay the claimant the amount of the deductions in the sum of $\underline{\textbf{£1,151.64}}$ net.

2. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of <u>£961.52</u> by way of an award of two weeks' pay under section 38 of the Employment Act 2002.

3. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant by way of costs order under rule 75(1)(b) of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2004 the sum of <u>£160.00</u> for the issue fee paid by her.

4. The hearing listed on 28 April 2017 is cancelled.

THE EMPLOYMENT TRIBUNALS (INTEREST) ORDER 1990

Tribunal case number(s): 2401438/2017

Name of Miss S Doogan v BSB Electronics Ltd case(s):

The Employment Tribunals (Interest) Order 1990 provides that sums of money payable as a result of a judgment of an Employment Tribunal (excluding sums representing costs or expenses), shall carry interest where the full amount is not paid within 14 days after the day that the document containing the tribunal's written judgment is recorded as having been sent to parties. That day is known as "the relevant decision day". The date from which interest starts to accrue is called "the calculation day" and is the day immediately following the relevant decision day.

The rate of interest payable is that specified in section 17 of the Judgments Act 1838 on the relevant decision day. This is known as "the stipulated rate of interest" and the rate applicable in your case is set out below.

The following information in respect of this case is provided by the Secretary of the Tribunals in accordance with the requirements of Article 12 of the Order:-
