JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

1. The claims for disability discrimination, unfair dismissal, a redundancy payment, breach of contract (unpaid notice pay) and unpaid holiday pay are well founded and the remedy to which the claimants are entitled will be determined at a Remedy Hearing.
2. The hearing listed for 19 December 2017 at 9:45am at 2nd Floor, Kings Court, Earl Grey Way, Royal Quays, North Shields, Tyne and Wear NE29 6AR is converted to a Remedy Hearing before an Employment Judge sitting alone. The estimated length of hearing is two hours.
3. The claimant is ordered to bring to that hearing a statement of all sums claimed from the respondent and two copies of all documents relied on to support such claims.
4. The respondent will only be able to partake in the Remedy Hearing to the extent permitted by the Employment Judge.

REASONS

1. The claimant filed a claim with the Tribunal on 13 October 2017 which was served on the respondent on 16 October 2017.
2. The respondent has failed to file any response to the proceedings.
3. The claimant claims various sums from the respondent which are not specifically set out in the claim form and therefore I conclude that a Remedy Hearing is required.
