## **JUDGMENT**

#### The judgment of the tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant's claim for unlawful deduction from wages arising out of underpayment of wages whilst on suspension is dismissed upon withdrawal by the claimant.
- 2. I declare that the claimant's claim for unlawful deduction from wages arising out of failure to pay for travelling time as a mobile worker is not well-founded, fails and is dismissed.
- 3. I declare that the claimant was unfairly dismissed. The hearing is adjourned to enable the parties to resolve the issue of remedy between themselves. If that does not happen in 7 days, the parties should notify the tribunal forthwith, and I shall deal with the remedy decision in the absence of the parties.
