JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the tribunal is as follows:

- 1. The claim of failure to make reasonable adjustments is dismissed upon withdrawal.
- 2. The claim of unfair dismissal is not well founded.
- 3. The claim of wrongful dismissal is not well founded.
- 4. The claim of direct disability discrimination is not well founded.
- 5. The claim of discrimination arising from disability is not well founded.
- 6. The claim of harassment related to disability is not well founded.
- 7. The claim of victimisation is not well founded.
