JUDGMENT ON PRELIMINARY ISSUE

- 1. The claimant's condition of fear of confined spaces or claustrophobia did not amount to a disability as defined in the Equality Act 2010 at the material time because the Employment Judge concluded that the adverse impact of the condition on the claimant's ability to carry out day to day activities was not substantial.
- 2. The claimant's case of disability discrimination is dismissed.
