JUDGMENT

- 1. The Tribunal has jurisdiction to hear the Claimant's claim of unlawful deduction from wages, as it was brought within the statutory time limit.
- 2. The Respondent made unlawful deductions from the Claimant's wages, in the sum of £576 gross, calculated on her working eight hours a day, at £9 per hour, two days a week, for four weeks, between 5 March and 5 April 2018 and is ordered to pay the Claimant that sum.
