PRELIMINARY JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant's claim that she was wrongfully dismissed by the respondent is dismissed on her claim being withdrawn.
- 2. The claimant's claim that she was unfairly dismissed is dismissed because the claimant did not have two years' qualifying employment immediately prior to the date of her dismissal.
- 3. The claimant's application to amend her claim to include a claim that she was automatically unfairly dismissed for asserting a statutory right, of entitlement to a written statement of employment particulars or other such right, is refused.
