## **JUDGMENT**

The complaint that the claimant was not paid a redundancy payment is struck out.

## **REASONS**

- 1. The claimant complains that she was not paid a redundancy payment.
- 2. Section 155 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years service to bring a complaint of failure to receive a redundancy payment.
- 3. The claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore the claimant is not entitled to bring such a complaint.
- 5. The claimant has failed to give any reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaint should not be struck out.
- 6. Accordingly, the complaint of failure to receive a redundancy payment is struck out. The claimant's other complaints are not affected by this judgment.
