JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that:-

- 1. The respondent made an unlawful deduction from the claimant's wages and shall pay to the claimant the sum of £2,483.37 being the gross amount due.
- The respondent was in breach of contract in failing to reimburse the claimant expenses incurred by him in the course of his employment. The respondent shall accordingly pay damages to the claimant in the sum of £372.85 being the amount due and owing.
- 3. By its conduct of the proceedings the claimant has acted unreasonably and has pursued a case (being an entitlement to make a deduction from the claimant's wages or pursue a breach of contract claim against him) with no reasonable prospect of success. The respondent shall pay to the claimant the sum of £1,080 by way of reimbursement of the legal costs incurred by the claimant in the pursuit of his claim together with an additional sum of £224.50 being expenses necessarily incurred by the claimant in attending the hearing today, those 1 Case No: 1806928/2018
