The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- 2. The claimant was wrongfully dismissed.

- 4. The claimant's claim for race discrimination is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 5. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the sum of £12,116 within the next 28 days.
