Representation

For the Claimant: The claimant represented himself.

For the Respondent: The respondent did not attend and was not

represented.

JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant is no longer pursuing the claims for notice and redundancy pay, on the basis that he has received these amounts from the Insolvency Service. The claims are dismissed on the claimant's withdrawal of these claims.
- 2. The respondent made unlawful deductions from the claimant's wages as set out below, which the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant on net basis, without deduction of tax:
 - a. in respect of his pay for the period from 1 July to 7 August 2018; 5 weeks' net pay (including an average 'tronc' payment) of £2,054.80;

- b. in respect of 19 days, or 3.8 weeks' accrued but untaken holiday, of £1,561.65, again net.
- c. Pension contributions (both employer and employee contributions, the latter being deducted but never paid into the claimant's pension) for the period January to August 2018 of £598.80.
- 3. The total award (2 (a) to (c)) is therefore £4,215.50 net, with no deduction for taxes.
