RepresentationFor the Claimant:The claimant represented herself.For the Respondent:The respondent did not attend and was notrepresented.

JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The respondent breached the claimant's contract of employment by failing to per her one month's notice. The respondent is ordered to pay the claimant, without deduction of tax, \pounds **1,925.81**, net.
- 2. The respondent made unlawful deductions from the claimant's wages as set out below, which the respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant on net basis, without deduction of tax:
 - a. in respect of her pay for the period from 1 to 7 August 2018; 1 week's net pay (including an average 'tronc' payment) of **£444.42**;
 - b. her unpaid tronc payment for July of £320, net:

- c. Pension contributions (both employer and employee contributions, the latter being deducted but never paid into the claimant's pension) for the period January to August 2018 of **£598.80**.
- 3. The total award (1 and 2) is therefore **£3,289.03** net, with no deduction for taxes.
