- 1. The Claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- 2. It is just and equitable to reduce the basic award by 30% under s122(2) Employment Rights Act 1996.
- 3. It is just and equitable to reduce the compensatory award by 30% under s123(6) Employment Rights Act 1996.
- 4. The Claimant is not entitled to a redundancy payment.
- 5. The Respondent unreasonably failed to provide the Claimant with a written statement of reasons for dismissal contrary to s93(1)(a) Employment Rights Act 1996.
- 6. By consent, the Respondent shall pay to the Claimant the sum of £3,200.00 only under this judgment.
