JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The complaints that the claimant was subjected to detriments on the ground of making protected disclosures, other than the complaint against the second respondent relating to dismissal, are dismissed on withdrawal by the claimant.
- 2. The complaint against the second respondent that the claimant was subjected to the detriment of dismissal on the ground of making protected disclosures is not well founded.
- 3. The complaint of unfair dismissal against the first respondent is not well founded.
