JUDGMENT

- 1 The second respondent is removed from the proceedings. The correct respondent is Honeypot Group Operations Limited.
- 2 The claimant's complaint of unlawful deduction of wages for failure to pay holiday pay succeeds. The amount due is the claimant's entitlement for 18.3 days (23.3 5 taken) as he worked for the first respondent in July and August 2017 and the holiday year commences on 1 July and he left on 27 April 2017. The first respondent is ordered to pay the net sum of £711.77 (seven hundred and eleven pounds and 77 pence) to the claimant.
- 3 The claimant is not entitled to further sums because of the long hours he allegedly worked.
- 4 The first respondent has acted unreasonably in defending this claim and failing to attend the hearing. It is also ordered to pay £114 to the claimant for three hours preparation time at the rate of £38 per hour under rules 75, 76 and 79 Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013.
