JUDGMENT Rule 21 of the Employment Tribunal Rules of Procedure 2013

The judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that the claimant's complaint of unauthorised deduction from wages succeeds and the respondent shall pay the claimant the sum of £200.

REASONS

- 1. A copy of the claim form setting out the claimant's complaint was sent to the respondent on 13 November 2018.
- 2. In accordance with the terms of Rule 16 of the Rules to be found in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 the respondent was required to enter a response within twenty eight days of the date on which a copy of the claim was sent to it but failed to do so.
- 3. The Employment Judge decided that on the available material a determination could properly be made without a hearing.
- 4. The remedy to which the claimant is entitled for the claim totals £200.
