Miss Turner's claim

1. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of £2,907.66 (7 weeks at £415.38 per week).

Mr Hyatt's claim

2. The respondent has made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages and is ordered to pay the claimant the gross sum of £12,634.59 (14.6 weeks at £865.38 per week).

3. The respondent has failed to reimburse the claimant for expenses incurred, and I order the respondent to pay the claimant compensation in the sum of $\pounds 2,350.83$.

4. The respondent failed to provide the claimant with a written statement of employment particulars, and I order the respondent to pay the claimant 2 weeks gross salary for such failure in the sum of \pounds 1,076.00 (2 x \pounds 538 – the statutory cap on a week's gross wages being applied).

5. The total payable to Mr Hyatt by the respondent is £16,061.42.
