JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's claim of unfair dismissal is well founded;
 - a. by consent the basic award is assessed at £5295.50,
 - b. the respondent is ordered to pay that amount to the claimant.
 - c. the compensatory award is assessed at nil.
- 2. The respondent was in breach of the claimant's contract of employment in failing to pay notice;
 - a. by consent the damages are assessed at £2119.18.
 - b. the respondent is ordered to pay that amount to the claimant.
