Introduction

This has been a remote hearing to which the parties did not voice any objections. The form of remote hearing was recorded Audio (BT Meet Me). A face to face hearing was not held because of the present Covid 19 circumstances. These are deductions from wages/breach of contract/holiday pay claims; the employer's contract claims are clearly discernible in the response forms (although section 7 was not completed). All parties are litigants in person, and having explored the issues the parties were prepared to enter into a consent Judgment rather than wait for a considerably delayed hearing.

CONSENT JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimants' claims of unlawful deductions from wages/breach of contract/holiday pay succeed.
- 2. The net sums unpaid to the claimants but declared to the revenue/recorded on their pay slips for work in December and holiday pay are as follows):

Miss AM Osenko: £623.84. Ms M Rykaczewska: £1043.00

- 3. The respondent's employer's contract claim succeeds and the damages arising in respect of the breaches by the claimants are: £291.95 each.
- 4. The claimant's payslips for their work in December 2019 and holiday pay must be provided to them by the respondent within fourteen days of the sending of this Judgment.
- 5. The sums payable to each claimant within fourteen days of the sending of this judgment are:

Ms M Rykaczewska: £75
