JUDGMENT

- 1. The Claimants claims for holiday pay are dismissed on withdrawal.
- 2. The Claimants claim for breach of contract are dismissed.
- 3. The First Claimant's claim for failing to provide written reasons for dismissal under Section 92 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 is well founded and is awarded the sum of £525.
- 4. The Second Claimant's claim under section 92 Employment Rights Act is not well founded and is dismissed.
- 5. The First Claimant's claim for unfair dismissal is well found and is awarded the sum of £8762.
- 6. The Second Claimant's claim for unfair dismissal is well founded and is awarded the sum of £4250.

For the avoidance of doubts the sums above are not subject to recoupment.
