## JUDGMENT

The Respondent having not presented a response to the claims brought by the Claimant and having not attended the hearing today, it is the judgment of the Tribunal that:

1. The Respondent has acted in breach of contract and made unauthorised deductions from the Claimant's wages and is ordered to pay the Claimant the gross sum of **£6,831.86** made up as follows:

a. Unpaid salary for May and June 2019	-	3,455.31
b. Unpaid commissions for April, May and June 2019	-	1,288.76
<ul> <li>c. Unpaid pension contributions</li> </ul>	-	94.89
d. Unpaid expenses	-	69.80
e. Unpaid notice pay (three weeks)	-	2,019.24
f. Unpaid annual leave	-	403.86
Less payment received		500.00
Total due		6,831.86

- 2. The Respondent failed to provide the Claimant with a written statement of terms and conditions and is ordered to pay the sum of £2,100.00.
- 3. The Claimant is responsible for payment of tax and national insurance due on the above sums, if any.
