JUDGMENT

- 1. The Tribunal declares that the Respondent made an unauthorised deduction from wages. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the total gross sum of £1854.
- The Tribunal also declares that the Respondent failed to provide to the Claimant a statement of employment particulars in accordance with Section 1 of the Employment Rights Act 1996. The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant a sum of two weeks pay pursuant to Section 38 of the Employment Act 2002 of £614.77.
