## JUDGMENT

- (1) The claim for failure to give notice is well founded. The claimant is awarded 1 weeks' pay of £304.50. The claimant's hourly rate was £8.70 and her average weekly hours were 35 hours.
- (2) The claim for holiday pay is well founded. The claimant is awarded 1.34 weeks of holiday pay. The respondent is given credit for £261 already paid. Thus, the sum awarded is £147.03.
- (3) The claim for unauthorised deductions for non-payment of wages for May 2019 fails. The claimant was paid for 14 hours ((£121.80).
