JUDGMENT

Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 – Rule 21

The respondent having failed to present a response and on the information available to the employment tribunal, the following complaints are well-founded and succeed.

- 1. The claimant was dismissed in breach of contract in respect of notice and the respondent is ordered to pay damages to the claimant in the sum of £4,466.00. This is a gross amount and the claimant shall be responsible for the payment of any income tax and insurance contributions thereon.
- 2. The respondent has failed to pay the claimant's holiday entitlement and is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £2,143.68 in respect of accrued holiday pay. This is a gross amount and the claimant should be responsible for the payment of any income tax and national insurance contributions thereon.
- 3. The claimant was dismissed by reason of redundancy and the respondent is ordered to pay the claimant a redundancy payment in the sum of £2,625.00.
- 4. The claimant's complaint of unfair dismissal is well-founded and succeeds. The claimant's entitlement to a remedy for unfair dismissal is postponed to a date to be fixed.
