JUDGMENT

The unanimous decision of the Employment Tribunal is as follows:-

- 1. The Claimant's claim of constructive unfair dismissal pursuant to s.95 Employment Rights Act 1996 is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- 2. The Claimant's claim that the Respondent failed to make reasonable adjustments pursuant to sections 20 and 21 of the Equality Act 2010 ("EQA") is not well-founded and is dismissed.
- The Claimant's claim of direct disability discrimination pursuant to section 13 EQA is not well-founded and is dismissed.
