JUDGMENT

The claims of discrimination on the basis of race, age, and religion or belief are struck out.

REASONS

- 1. By a letter dated 26th of October 2020 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claims of discrimination arising on the grounds of race, and/or age, and/or religion/belief should not be struck out because they had no reasonable prospect of success.
- 2. The claimant has failed to make sufficient representations, why this should not be done or to request a hearing. In particular he has not identified a religion or belief, the act of discrimination to which he refers occurred in 2015 and he has not provided any information that others who are on an old the contract have also been dismissed. These claims are therefore struck out.
