JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of this Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claimant's claim that she was dismissed contrary to s95 Employment Rights Act 1996 (ERA) and was unfairly dismissed contrary to S94 fails and is dismissed.
- 2. The claimant's claims for direct disability discrimination contrary to S13 EQA 2010 and associative disability discrimination were not pursued and are dismissed.
- 3. The claimant's claim for discrimination arising from disability contrary to S15 Equality Act 2010 ("EQA 2010") fails and is dismissed.
- 4. The claimant's claim for indirect disability discrimination contrary to S19 EQA 2010 fails and is dismissed.
- 5. The claimant's claim of disability related harassment contrary to S26 EQA 2010 fails and is dismissed.
- 6. The claimant's claim for indirect sex discrimination contrary to S19 EQA 2010 fails and is dismissed.
- 7. The claimant's claim for unlawful deduction from wages contrary to S23 ERA 1996 fails and is dismissed.
