JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The claim of unfair dismissal is well founded and succeeds.
- 2. The claim for unlawful deduction from wages is well founded and I make a declaration to that effect.
- 3. The Respondent failed to provide the claimant with an itemised pay statement in accordance with S8 Employment Rights Act 1996 and I make a declaration to that effect. I also make a determination that the pay slip would have shown £507 as the gross sum to the claimant with a net sum of £400 per week.
- 4. The claimant's claim for wrongful dismissal is not upheld.
- 5. The claimant's claim for a failure to consult under Transfer of Undertakings (Protection of Employment) Regulations 2006 is not upheld.

Remedy

- 6. The Respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the net sum of £6,084 as a basic award.
- 7. The Respondent is ordered to pay the claimant the net sum of £5,600 in relation to his claim for unlawful deduction from wages.

8. The Respondent is ordered to pay the claimant to net sum of $\pounds 3,865$ as a compensatory award.
