## JUDGMENT

- 1. The claimant's claim that she was unfairly dismissed is well founded and succeeds.
- 2. The claimant's claim that she was dismissed in breach of contract is successful.
- 3. The claimant's claim that she was not paid her holiday pay outstanding on termination of employment in accordance with regulation 14 of the Working Time Regulations 1998 is successful.
- The claimant was not given itemised pay statements that contain the particulars required to be included in a pay statement in accordance with section 8(2)(e) of the Employment Rights Act 1996.
- For the purposes of section 38 Employment Act 2002, at the date when these proceedings started, the respondent was in breach of his duty under section 4 Employment Rights Act 1996 to give the claimant a written statement of particulars of change of particulars to be given under section 1 Employment Rights Act 1996.

6. Remedy will be determined at a hearing on 28 May 2021.
