## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The claimant's complaints of <u>unfair dismissal</u>; <u>suffering a detriment for a reason that relates to pregnancy, childbirth or maternity and unpaid holiday pay are <u>dismissed</u> as having been presented out of time. These complaints were presented after the expiry of the statutory time limit. That time limit cannot be extended because it was reasonably practicable for the claimant to present her claim within the time limit.</u>
- 2. The claimant's complaint of <u>discrimination on the grounds or pregnancy or maternity leave</u> was presented after the expiry of the statutory time limit. However it is just and equitable to extend time to the date of presentation. The <u>Tribunal has jurisdiction to consider that complaint, which will proceed hearing.</u>
