JUDGMENT

It is the unanimous decision of the Employment Tribunal that:

- 1. The claimant's complaints of direct sex discrimination and harassment related to sex are not well founded and are dismissed;
- The claimant's complaint of unauthorised deduction of wages in respect of the pay due for March 2020 is well founded. The claimant is awarded the gross sum of £36.82;
- 3. The claimant's remaining complaints of unauthorised deduction from wages are not well founded and are dismissed.
