## **JUDGMENT**

The unanimous Judgment of the Tribunal is

- (1) The Claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- (2) The Respondents discriminated against the Claimant in failing to make reasonable adjustments.
- (3) The claim of direct discrimination because of disability is withdrawn and dismissed by the Tribunal.
- (4) The claim of discrimination arising from disability in relation to allegedly failing to agree or consider the Claimant's suggestion to move from a sales role at the meeting of 13 January 2020 is withdrawn and dismissed by the Tribunal. The other claim of discrimination arising from disability namely pulling the Claimant into a meeting on 13 January 2020 and accusing her of making colleagues walk on eggshells is dismissed.
- (5) The Claimant was wrongfully dismissed.
- (6) The claim of harassment is dismissed.
- (7) If the parties cannot agree remedy, then application should be made to the Tribunal within 7 days of the date of sending this judgment giving dates of availability for a Remedy Hearing for the months of May to September 2021 inclusive. Unless the parties indicate otherwise any Remedy Hearing

will be given a time estimate of 1 day. The parties are encouraged to use their best endeavours to agree remedy. If the parties do agree remedy, they should write to the Tribunal indicating that there is no need for a Remedy Hearing.
