## **JUDGMENT**

Following discussion with the parties, the judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- 1. The sick pay claim is dismissed following a withdrawal of the claim by the claimant;
- 2. The claimant's claim for holiday pay is well founded due to concession by the respondent; the parties having reached agreement on the outstanding sum due it is ordered that the agreed sum of £235.88 be paid by the respondent to the claimant;
- 3. The claimant's claim for failure to provide a statement of employment particulars is conceded and well founded, but remedy remains outstanding and will be determined with the outstanding unfair dismissal and wages claims at a later date (whose merits remain undetermined).
