JUDGMENT

- Mr Ahtom's claim for breach of contract (expenses) succeeds and he is awarded £67.38 relating to petrol and food expenses arising from a training day (Senior Architectural Systems).
- 2. Mr Ahtom's claim for unauthorised deductions from wages (pay and unpaid expenses) succeeds and he is awarded:
 - 2.1 £728.87 (gross) in relation to his overtime pay for the weeks commencing 2, 9 and 16 December 2019; and
 - 2.2 £359.19 (gross) in relation to three days' accrued holiday pay for 1, 2 and 3 January 2020.

NOTES

- 3. The Tribunal has issued a separate judgment in respect of the complaint of the claimants that the respondent failed to comply with the requirements of s188 of the Trade Union & Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992.
- 4. I have considered the information and documents provided by the claimant by email to the Tribunal in reaching the Judgment set out above, together with the documentary and oral evidence provided by the other claimants to the multiple claim of Mrs Gunning & Others against the respondent. That evidence included the spreadsheet of bonuses accrued (page 71 of the hearing file for the hearing held on 16 November 2019).
