JUDGMENT

The claim of unfair dismissal is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The claimant complains of unfair dismissal.
- 2. The claimant has not explained any basis upon which the Tribunal might have jurisdiction to hear a claim of unfair dismissal where 2 years' service is required unless dismissal is said to be for an automatically unfair reason.
- 3. No such reason, as recognised in the Employment Rights Act 1996, has been raised.
- 4. Therefore, the claimant is not entitled to bring these proceedings.
- 5. The Claimant's complaint of breach of contract will proceed.
- 6. The Tribunal notes that whilst the Claimant refers to discrimination in her representations, that is not a complaint brought in these proceedings.
- 7. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaint of unfair dismissal should not be struck out.
- 8. Accordingly, the claim of unfair dismissal is struck out.
