JUDGMENT

The claim is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. The claimant complains of unfair dismissal.
- 2. Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years service to make an unfair dismissal complaint.
- 3. The claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore the claimant is not entitled to bring such a complaint.
- 5. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the complaint should not be struck out.
- 6. Accordingly, the complaint of unfair dismissal is struck out.
- 7. The claimant also failed to attend the listed hearing on 2nd December 2021 or to provide any reason for non-attendance, despite being given the opportunity to do so and being put on notice that failure to give an explanation would lead to consideration of a strike out.
- 8. Accordingly, all further complaints are also struck out on the grounds that they are not being actively pursued.
