## JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Employment Tribunal is that:

1. The claimant's complaint that the respondent made an unlawful deduction from her wages succeeds in part.
2. The respondent shall pay to the claimant the sum of $£ 1,853.40$ being the wages unlawfully deducted for 225.75 hours of work at the relevant national minimum wage rate of £8.21 per hour.
3. The claimant's claim that she suffered an unlawful deduction from her wages for a further 55.5 hours of work undertaken by her for the respondent shall be determined by the Tribunal at the final hearing.
4. The respondent shall pay the amount ordered to be paid to the claimant of $£ 1,853.40$ on or before 3 July 2020.
