# **JUDGMENT**

The hearing has been a remote hearing which was not objected to by the parties. The form of remote hearing was video by Cloud Video Platform (CVP). A face-to-face hearing was not held because it was not practicable because of the Covid-19 virus.

- 1. The claimant was unfairly dismissed.
- 2. A 75% reduction in the compensatory award for unfair dismissal will be made under the principles in **Polkey v A E Dayton Services Limited 1988 ICR 142**.
- 3. The claimant contributed to his dismissal to the extent of 25%, to be applied to the basic award for unfair dismissal.
- 4. The respondent shall pay to the claimant compensation for unfair dismissal of £6,325.31 gross, as follows:

Basic Award: £2,625, minus 25% contributory fault, equals £1,968.75.

Compensatory Award: £4,356.56, comprised as follows:

£7,100.72 loss of earnings, £9,393.31 loss of future earnings £400 loss of statutory rights

Equals £16,903.82.

Minus £2,962.80 payment in lieu of notice, equals £13,941.02.

Minus 75% reduction, equals £3,485.25.

Plus 25% increase for failure to follow the ACAS Code of Practice of £871.31, equals £4,356.56.
