## JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Tribunal is that the claimant is entitled to gross awards as follows:

Unpaid wages	£1130.22
Accrued holiday pay	£240.00
Total Award:	<b>£1370.22</b>

### REASONS

1 The claimant submitted two claim forms to the Employment Tribunal, one claiming unpaid wages and the second claiming accrued holiday pay.

2 The claimant, in his claim forms, did not identify the respondent by his full name. The respondent did not return an ET3. The Tribunal permitted the claims to be amended to the full name of the respondent, Mr Bertrand Lenet.

3 The claimant was employed as a waiter. He was not paid wages for the period 22 February to 18 March 2020 of £1130.22. He had accrued 4 days of holiday pay amounting to £240. These are the sums awarded.
