## JUDGMENT

- (1) The Claimant's claim for unfair dismissal is struck out on the basis that she does not have 2 years qualifying service and the Tribunal lacks jurisdiction to deal with it.
- (2) The Respondent was in breach of contract by dismissing the Claimant without notice.
- (3) The Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant the sum of £7,500.00 gross, being damages for the breach of contract.
- (4) Rule 69: If the Respondent is able to do so, it must account to HMRC and if not, the Claimant is to account to HMRC.
