# JUDGMENT

### The hearing has been a remote hearing which was not objected to by the parties. The form of remote hearing was video by Cloud Video Platform (CVP). A face-to-face hearing was not held because it was not practicable because of the Covid-19 virus.

- 1. The claimant's claim of unauthorised deduction of wages was well founded and succeeds.
- The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £797.50 gross, comprising £697.50 for two week's unpaid wages, plus £100 for unpaid overtime.
