# **JUDGMENT**

- 1. The Claimant's claim of unfair dismissal is well founded and succeeds.
- 2. The Claimant has contributed to his own dismissal and a deduction shall be made for contributory fault of 25% under s.122 and s.123 Employment Rights Act 1996

- 4. The Claimant's dismissal was wrongful, and he is entitled to notice pay in an amount to be determined.
