This hearing has taken place on a remote basis by CVP platform in accordance with the Presidential Practice Direction on remote hearings and open justice and in accordance with Rule 46 ET (CRP) Regs 2013 and the Guidance issued on 14th September 2020.

JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

- 1. The claimant's claim that he was unfairly dismissed under s103A ERA 1996 for making a protected disclosure succeeds.
- 2. It is declared that the principal reason for the claimant's dismissal was he made protected disclosures by way of two emails one on 21 November 2019 and the other on 22 November 2019 each sent to the Respondent.
- 3. It is declared that the information in the two emails each amount to a protected disclosure. The Respondent accepts the information in the email disclosure on 22 November was a protected disclosure in any event.

- 4. The claimant's claim that he was subjected to a detriment by reason of making the protected disclosures succeeds to the extent it is declared that the claimant was isolated at work by the respondent prior to his dismissal as a result of making the protected disclosures.
- 5. The issue of compensation will be dealt with on 9 July 2021.
