JUDGMENT

The Employment Tribunal Judge gave judgment as follows:-

Pursuant to a merits judgment sent to the parties on 29 September 2019:-

1. Basic Award

Pursuant to section 122(2) of the Employment Rights Act it would be just and equitable to reduce the basic award by 60% having regard to the conduct of the complainant before the dismissal. Therefore the Claimant is entitled to a basic award of $\pounds 2,310.00$.
