JUDGMENT

The complaint of unfair dismissal is struck out.

REASONS

- 1. One of the claimant's complaints is unfair dismissal.
- 2. Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have had not less than two years service with the respondent to make most kinds of unfair dismissal complaint. The claimant's unfair dismissal complaint is not of a kind that he can make without two years service.
- 3. The claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years. Therefore, he is not entitled to bring his unfair dismissal complaint.
- 4. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the unfair dismissal complaint should not be struck out.
- 5. Accordingly, the unfair dismissal complaint is struck out, on the basis that it has no reasonable prospects of success.
- 6. The claimant's wrongful dismissal / notice pay complaint is not affected. There will be a 2 hour final hearing to deal with that complaint. A notice of hearing and some case management orders will follow separately.
